G.S.R. - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in super-session of the Central Bureau of Health Intelligence, (Group 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1983, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Multi Tasking Staff (MTS) under the plan scheme "Strengthening of Health Information and Monitoring System-Establishment of Field Survey Units (i.e. Patna, Lucknow and Jaipur) in the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Directorate General of Health Services, Central Bureau of Health Intelligence, namely:-

- 1 . **Short Title and commencement** – (i) These rules may be called the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Directorate General of Health Services, Central Bureau of Health Intelligence, Multi Tasking Staff (Group 'C') Recruitment Rules, 2025 (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Number of post, classification and level in pay-matrix** – The number of the said post, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3 . **Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.**– The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
4. **Disqualification** – No person, -
 - a (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such

<p>Note:The crucial date for determining the age-limit shall be the closing date for the receipt of applications from candidates and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Tripura, Sikkim, Lahaul and Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh and the Union Territories of Ladakh, Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep.</p>

5. **Power to relax** – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving** - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of person in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
